### CHARLOTTE JONES – WINNER PROFILE

**Age:** 26

**From:** Cumbria



**Race Riding Career:** Licensed since 2016, Charlotte is Conditional to James Moffatt. She has had 33 winners from 171 rides and had her best season this year, becoming the first female to be leading rider at her local track Cartmel in 2021.

**CPD Highlights:** Charlotte already qualified with a first class degree Equine Science degree before becoming a jockey. She has made huge efforts to improve her riding technique having regular sessions and course walks with her coach Brian Harding. She has used the PJA Nutrition team and visited Liverpool John Moores to examine bone density and also has worked with Performance Consultant Aodhagan Conlon with some breathing techniques to help with pre-race nerves. She is using the Train Heroic fitness app set up through the Strength & Conditioning team at Jack Berry

House. Away from the track, Charlotte has focused on her education, completing BHS teaching qualifications and her Level 3 Diploma in Horse Management and is working towards her BHA Level 4. Alongside her riding, she has also launched a gin brand with her boyfriend and group of friends. She also buys and sells ponies and has been making some property investments to help prepare for the future.

**Charlotte said:** “Obviously being a jockey and working on other things at the same time is difficult but you have to keep one eye on the future. I’m putting everything into my riding and ultimately I just want to keep getting better.”

**Race Riding Career:** First licensed in 2012. Had over 280 rides and 20 winners as an Apprentice and 2 winners as an Amateur. Biggest win in the Lady Cecil Morpheus Handicap Class 2 at Nottingham on Gracious John.

**Career Development:** During her riding career, Kathy has used JETS for support and advice, whilst also grappling with upheaval in her personal life. She has always embraced her personal development doing various bookkeeping and accounting courses whilst riding and using time off injured to undertake a work placement for an accountancy firm. However, her passion remains with horses and with the support of

JETS, she completed a fast track two year, self-study Chemistry A level. She passed with an A\* grade enabling her to take up a place at St Edmund's College at Cambridge University to study Veterinary Medicine which she began in October 2021.

### RODI GREENE – WINNER PROFILE

**Age:** 51

**From:** Devon

**Second Career:** BHA Regional Jockey Coach



**Race Riding Career:** Rodi rode for 23 years as a Jump jockey from 1988 to 2011 with over 5000 rides and 350 winners including the Cheltenham Festival's Coral Cup in 2002 aboard Ilnamar and the Sky Bet Chase in 2003 on Barryscourt Lad.

**Career Development:** Rodi suffered a career ending fall and during recovery was approached about coaching jockeys which was still in its infancy at that time. Rodi started coaching in 2012 and has since gained his UKCC Level 3 Jockey Coaching qualification and earlier this year was appointed a full time BHA Regional Coach covering the south of the country. Over the years, Rodi has used all his experience to help nurture jockeys from the pony racing circuit right the way through to winning Championships and currently looks after 35 Flat and Jump jockeys. Rodi has used JETS both during his riding career and beyond, most recently in preparing his application for the Regional Coaching role. He has coached big names such as Tom Marquand, Hollie Doyle and Harry Cobden but his aim is to help every jockey reach their potential, adopting an individual approach for each one, always being accessible and making sure he addresses every aspect of their lives both in and out of the saddle.

**Rodi said:** “I would go as far to say that Jockey coaching has saved me. A job in racing is all I have ever known as it is something I love with a real passion. My own career has been a dream come true and I hope to continue to help as many young jockeys as possible achieve theirs.”
